We are looking for a small team of confident, musical, responsible, caring and dynamic young people to form our pastoral team.

Duties and responsibilities will include:

- Providing leadership and guidance to a group of up to ten 14-18 year old students
- Being a teacher, source of support, and mentor to each student on the programme; particularly within your mentor group.
- Ensuring that all students are aware of and adhere to the Ingenium safety regulations and emergency procedures
- Monitoring student's behaviour, applying appropriate behaviour management and reporting to the Ingenium leadership team.
- Organising and participating in evening activities (i.e. team games, discos, quiz nights, movie nights, talent shows and barbeques)
- Being part of the airport transfers team, meeting and greeting students at airports/railway stations and accompanying them to Winchester on our coaches.
- Planning and running Sunday afternoon activities (ie. sport, arts and crafts, theatre, English language booster sessions)
- Devising and leading activities for student's spare time (ie. composition clubs etc.)
- Taking registers
- Ensuring students participate in all workshops and activities
- Aiding and encouraging students in their private practice time
- Chaperoning students on all day trips
- Supervising meal times
- Providing supervision on a rota basis (including nights)
- Setting an example to all students by following Ingenium rules and regulations at all times
- Cooperating with the entire Ingenium staff to ensure the smooth running of the programme
- Running small chamber groups / taking warm ups and rehearsing / teaching small groups of musicians

NB. this position is residential and you must be available to live on campus at Winchester College for the dates of your employment. All accommodation and meals are provided.
